STUDENT SUPPORT PLAN

August 11, 2020

Per the Governor’s Executive Order 2020-51 Tombstone Unified School District is offering students/parents the following instructional support plan. Tombstone Unified School District will be open at **7:45 am.** and parent pickup begins at **2:45 pm.** Since all of our students are children of essential workers or Title one students we offer the following for instructional support plan. Parents must drive students to campus as there will be no district transportation offered.

Attending students will have their temperature taken at the arrival gate. Students who have a temperature higher than 100.4 will be sent home with their parents so we ask that you wait to drive away until your child’s temperature has been taken.

A staff member will supervise the students in a classroom throughout the day. Students will be required to log in and participate in their online grade level appropriate classroom. Parents will be required to pick up students at 2:45 pm. Picking up students later than 10 minutes more than three times will result in possible termination of these benefits.

While this service is available to all of our students we ask that when you can keep your children at home that you do so to minimize any COVID transfer. We have a large number of students that will be receiving instruction remotely according to the schedule below.

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Executive Order 2020-51 requires that face coverings for all adults and students over the age of 5.
The requirement for masks applies to on-site support services and will be in place on August 17th.

**Unfortunately, at this time no visitors will be allowed on campus
except to pick up a child from the office.**

We are following the CDC recommended guidelines to implement strategies to reduce the spread of COVID-19 by doing the following:

- **We are promoting** behaviors that reduce spread like social distancing, washing hands, using sanitizing stations, electrostatic sprayers and sprayer for playground equipment and wearing cloth face coverings),
- **We are maintaining environments** like ensuring proper ventilation, cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched surfaces frequently throughout the day
- **We are maintaining healthy operations** staggering schedules, keeping students in small groups or larger areas with appropriate social distancing.

- **When a child gets sick or has a temperature above 100.4 degrees** your child will be moved to the Sick Bay and monitored until a parent arrives. Once called, please ensure that you can pick your child up immediately. This is essential when someone gets sick because the person assigned to stay with the child is taken away from their regular duty.
- **We are not providing classroom face to face in person classes at this time.** Although teachers may be in their respective classes they will be recording or providing live stream lessons to their students each day as required according to the district calendar. Student will receive the same number of days and hours of instruction as mandated by the Executive Order 2020-51. On Site learners will be required to log on and view their respective grade level teacher's lesson on a district provided electronic device.
- **On Sight Learners** will currently be housed on the cafeteria stage, in the library, unused classrooms, the commons or in the gymnasium depending on the number of students in attendance. Teachers will be using their classrooms for remote instruction.
- **We are providing services for students with disabilities** whose free appropriate public education (FAPE) needs, as determined by individualized education program (IEP) teams, require in-person support and must be provided specially-designed instruction as soon as the student has started school, in accordance with the attending school calendar.
- **We are providing meals** one half hour before the start of school at each school. Lunch will be served on a staggered schedule after 4th period at HCS and WJM. The High School will stagger lunches after 2nd Block.
- **We are providing paraprofessional support** and access to internet and devices for distance learning instruction for all attending students.
- **We will still be providing medical and mental health services** delivered by qualified healthcare providers and certified counselors at each school.
- **We will still be providing targeted support** delivered by qualified educators for development of English language and literacy skills as well teacher-led instruction and/or tutoring for a subset of academically at-risk students.
- **We will still be providing supervision and academic support** for young students who do not have a caregiver at home during school hours.
- **We will still be providing** targeted support for children in foster care, including family foster homes and congregate care settings.
- **We will continually assess** and prepare options for staff who fall into health-risk categories and consider implications.
- **We consistently consider** the expertise of our staff to ensure that the needs of students are being met by the most highly skilled and qualified staff available.

Please be assured that we are trying to be all things to all people that in all ways we may adequately serve as many of our students as possible. Thank you for your continued support.
