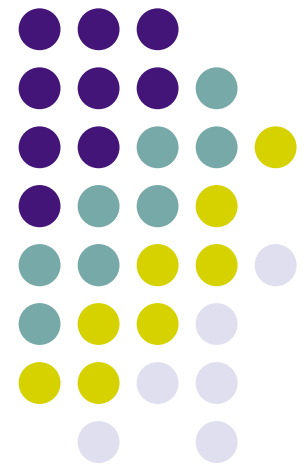
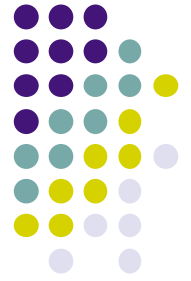

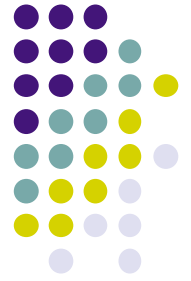
What is Title I?



- It is the largest federal aid program for public schools. Schools can be designated as “Title I” if certain criteria are met.
- This program provides additional funds for educating disadvantaged children. These funds are designated to assist children in meeting challenging academic standards.
- Title I is the federal government’s commitment to closing the achievement gap between low-income and moderate to high-income students.



What does Title I require?



- Challenging Curriculum aligned to standards
- Accountability
- Academic Assessments
- Language Assessments & Academic Assessments of English Language Proficiency
- Address low academic achievement
- School Improvement Plan with Peer Review



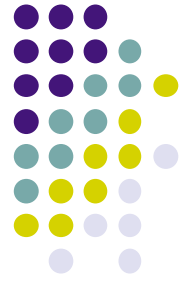
What does Title I require?

 - Attend meetings to design effective programs

 - Be actively involved in your child's education

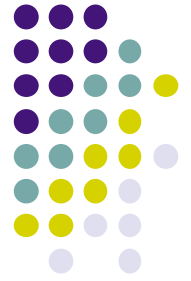


How can we use Title I dollars?



- Provide after-school, summer, or intercession programs
- Train parents, teachers, and other staff
- Buy equipment, materials, supplies
- Support parent involvement activities
- Hire teachers, assistants, specialists, etc.

- **Supplies for McKinney Vento Identified Students (\$1,487.85)**



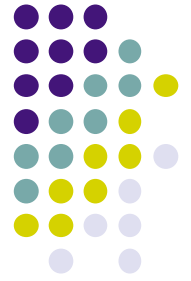
Assessments to Measure Student Growth



- DiBELS (k-3 reading)
- AzM2 (state assessment, K-8, 10 in ELA, Math)
- AIMS Science (4, 8, 11 grades)
- PowerTest (K-12)/Performance Matters (3-11)
- AZELLA (K-12 if needed for ELL students)
- Curriculum Based Assessments
- Teacher Created Assessments



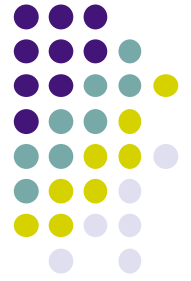
