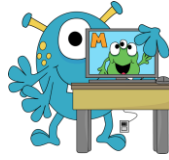


Using Green Screen to Increase Student Participation

1. Get a green screen (6ft x 6ft neon green felt). You can get the felt at Joann's or you can order a kit from PlaySpark Toys.
2. Get or create backgrounds – most are in PowerPoint or PDF format
 - a. Export PowerPoint as a PDF
 - b. Use smallpdf.com to convert the PDF into a jpeg
3. Load backgrounds on to Zoom
4. Have fun with your class!

- Paint sticks with green felt wrapped around them
- Green felt pockets
- Green sleeves
- Extra material for hide and seek
