Eligibility Requirements and Supplemental Information Needed

1. Applicants must be graduating from High School in the year the scholarship is awarded.
2. **Applicants must be a member of ViaCU for at least one year prior to the March 15th application deadline.**
3. Cumulative high school grade point average must be at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale ("B" or above).
4. A typed, double-spaced essay of at least one page in length, but not to exceed two pages, must be attached to this application. The essay should include information about the applicant and plans for the future. The applicant should mention any unusual financial burden to self or family in the essay as well.
5. A copy of applicant's high school **transcript** must be provided (which should include your SAT and/or ACT score).
6. Two completed Reference Forms must be received from applicants' guidance counselor AND teacher. The applicant should provide each reference with a stamped envelope addressed to:

7. The application and reference forms must be on file at ViaCU on or before March 15. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure Reference Forms are submitted to ViaCU by deadline.
8. All materials become the property of the selection committee and interviews may be scheduled, if necessary.
9. Awards will only be available once proof of college registration is received.
10. Scholarship awards will be made payable to the recipient and to the college/university/trade school he/she is attending.
