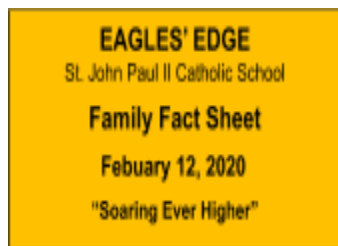


## “Christ, my hope, has risen. Alleluia!” (Easter Sequence)
