Dear Families,

The re-enrollment period for the 2021-22 school year will be coming up in the next couple of weeks. More information will be sent to you from our enrollment manager, Lisa Noyes, (office@jp2catholicschool.org), including a new fee and tuition schedule and other pertinent information. There will be a limited priority time frame to re-enroll your child(ren). Please be responsive when you receive this information so that we can ensure the placement of current students and move the process along for the many new applicants. As has been the case in recent years, we have far more applications than we have space. Last year there were over 120 applications to our school, and several students, in a variety of grades, were placed on a waitlist. Once re-enrollment is complete, the admissions committee will start considering applications from siblings, local parishioners, Catholic families beyond the local parishes, and then all other applications. The date an application is received and completed is a consideration in the decision to accept a new student. Nancy Sheets is our admissions coordinator (nsheets@jp2catholicschool.org), and she will be shepherding the applications through the admissions process.
