Dear Families,

Achieving continuity of learning through meaningful and effective distance teaching and learning is our goal moving forward. The faculty and staff have been busy this week getting ready to engage in the process of achieving this goal, and as is usually the case, they have risen to the occasion. Some teachers and classes have already begun, but the official start for most of you is tomorrow. We will do our utmost to provide your children a structured school day which reflects what they have been experiencing all year long here on campus. The staff will be as responsive as possible to communications to and from students and parents as is feasible during regular school hours (7:30-3:30). Teachers will reach out to students and parents directly each day. Please set up a suitable place for your child(ren) in your home where they can simulate the classroom experience with the least amount of disruption and appropriate level of supervision. Access to technology will be necessary for the school work, but some of what needs to be done can be accomplished without technology. Teachers are being very creative creating videos of instruction, offering links to lessons, and offering conference calling and conferencing to maintain teacher-student contact. Share your challenges with your child's teacher, and we will do our best to assist in any way we can. This is a work in progress. Thank you for your understanding, cooperation, and assistance. I encourage you all during these trying times to remain calm, use common sense, be creative, and stay united. Be prayerful and stay healthy.
