



VOLUNTARY VISION

Eligible employees may choose to enroll in voluntary vision coverage, which is offered through Vision Service Plan (VSP). Under the plan, you pay the cost for your voluntary vision plan premiums. You may visit any vision care provider, but benefits are provided at significantly higher levels when you visit an in-network doctor.

Using your VSP benefit is easy:

Create an account at www.vsp.com. Once your plan is effective, review your benefit information, and find an eye doctor who's right for you. At your appointment, tell them you have VSP. There's no ID card necessary. If you'd like a card for reference, you can print one at vsp.com.
