Dear Students and Parents,

You will find attached to this letter an “Electronic Information Services User Agreement”. This is a fancy name for a permission slip. We are asking you for permission to allow your son or daughter to use computers, and especially the Internet, for educational purposes. We encourage you to carefully review the enclosed agreement and discuss it with your child before signing and returning it.

The Internet has great potential for enhancing the level of excellence in education that we can offer your child. However, it also has potential of providing a source of inappropriate material. We want to be sure that parents and students understand their responsibilities when using computers. We also want parents to be aware of the safeguards the school district provides. Together, parents and the school district can ensure appropriate, wholesome learning.

Not only can software and Internet programs be used inappropriately, so can the hardware. We have an obligation to keep expensive equipment in good repair. We must rely on students to use the hardware in such a manner that the equipment is not destroyed or damaged.

**USE OF ELECTRONIC INFORMATION SERVICES IN INSTRUCTION
TECHNOLOGY USER AGREEMENT – PARENT/GUARDIAN CONSENT
Grades Kindergarten through Sixth Grade**

Please read this document carefully. When signed it becomes a binding agreement.

As guardian of _____, I have read the School District Technology Policy and discussed it with my child. I understand the goal set forth by the district regarding my child using EIS (Electronic Information Services) and possibly other electronic equipment.

I consent to the monitoring of any use of Electronic Information Services by my child. I understand my child will have supervision while using computers and computer-related equipment. My child will use electronic communication services only with teacher supervision.

I support the stated guidelines for safe use of the Internet and will discuss and reinforce these concepts with my child. Use of the Internet will be monitored with Internet filtering software in place in order to make every effort to ensure access to appropriate materials.

Internet Safety Guidelines:

- Never reveal personal information such as last name, address, telephone number, parents' work address/telephone number, or the name and location of my school without parent permission.
- Inform a responsible adult if any information is accessed that makes me feel uncomfortable.
- Never agree to get together with someone I may meet online.
- Never send anyone a personal photograph.
- Do not respond to messages that are mean or cause uncomfortable feelings.

I agree to pay any costs of repair to hardware and/or software that my child may damage through misuse or violation of District policy or regulation. (We ask parents to assist us in training students to help us care for this very expensive equipment. Our desire is to provide the very best our district resources can provide.)

Should my child violate any aspect of the policy, I understand and agree that my child could lose computer use privileges for a designated period of time.

I give permission for my child use electronic equipment (including the Internet) at school. I will assist the school district in supporting the policies and procedures by helping my child learn the proper skills and etiquette when using the computer.
