- Student use of SLHS's parking lot is a **privilege not a right**. A yearly parking permit fee will be charged. If a student fails to follow general rules regarding the use of the parking lot, the privilege will be denied.
- All vehicles must have a SLHS parking decal/permit visibly posted on their rear view mirror or on their left front driver's window.
- I understand that my permit cannot be loaned to another person or placed in another person's vehicle.
- I understand that the speed limit of the campus is 15mph and that I may only park in the assigned area of the student parking lot.
- I understand that the only entrance and exit to SLHS is the Southeast entrance. (By the auditorium)
- I understand that I can be cited for violations of parking and driving laws, rules and regulations, and that the consequences of violating these laws, rules, and regulations can be, but not limited to: fines, fees, towing, loss of driving privilege on campus, and other school consequences.
- I hereby release and hold harmless Show Low School District, its employees, and any other agency working with or for Show Low School District from any loss or liability due to an accident, damage, theft, or injury that may arise from parking, driving or removal of a vehicle on school property.
- If students are involved in a car accident on campus, they must report it immediately to the police department. The school district is not responsible for personal injury, damage to a vehicle, theft of items in a vehicle or theft of a vehicle.
- The district retains authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots and inspections of exterior and interior (following established legal guidelines) of student vehicles on school property. Depending on the circumstance (i.e. visual sighting of something illegal, random dog sniffing, etc.), such patrols and inspections may be conducted without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant.
- If a police drug dog alerts on your vehicle, the school or police agency is not responsible for damages.
- A student who fails to provide access to the interior of the car upon reasonable request by a school official will be subject to the school's disciplinary action.
- No small motorized vehicles such as scooters, pocket bikes, and mopeds are allowed. **Only licensed and insured drivers and vehicles are allowed on campus.**
- Students must follow **all rules** and **drive safely** to keep the privilege of driving on campus. Student must obey directions and instructions of the adult(s) on parking lot duty. If a student fails to follow the school policy and procedures related to the use of vehicles, the driver will be disciplined according to SLHS policy.
- I acknowledge that Show Low Unified School District does not provide any security or insurance for my vehicle, and I assume all risk of damage to or destruction of my vehicle while it is driven or parked on property of Show Low School District.
- I hereby acknowledge and state that I have read or have had read to me and understand and agree to abide by and obey all laws, rules, and regulations relating to the use of a motor vehicle on the Show Low High School Campus as stated above.
