When applying for any scholarship be sure to consider the following:

- NEVER pay a fee to find a scholarship- There are no guarantees anyone can get you a scholarship.
- Use FREE scholarship search engines to identify appropriate scholarships. See complete list below and choose at least 2 that apply. Keep track of deadlines and due dates
- Ask a trusted and informed adult to review your application before submitting
- Ask a parent/guardian if their employer offers scholarships?
- Have a resume available so you can highlight your talents both academically and socially
- Be sure to have opened a professional email account-First and Last name is sufficient- Nothing like “ lovemycat@yahoo.com”.
- Dedicate the same time and day to apply to scholarships every week. For example every Sunday from 1-3 pm. This habit will result in banking most scholarship money. For even better results find an accountability partner and apply with a friend.
- Talk with your school counselor about all the ways to find funding for post high school education opportunities
- Once you have applied and have accepted entrance in any post high school institution check out that schools unique scholarship search engine. Every school has one.
- Speak with a college admissions specialist for specific scholarships you may qualify for
- Be aware that Financial aid scholarships are based on financial need requirements
- Be patient and persevere in the process. **APPLY AND APPLY AND APPLY AGAIN!**

NPC SCHOLARSHIPS

Students interested in taking advantage of dual enrollment and college credits during and after high school have a number of opportunities through NPC.

College Bound

- Covers up to 7 AGEC credits per semester (Tuition Only)
- Open to all high school and home school students in Navajo & Apache Counties
- Must be at least 14 years old to apply
- Must have at least a 2.6 GPA or meet required placement test scores
- Students can utilize this up to 28 credits
- Available for fall and spring semesters
- Funds are limited and awarded on a first come, first serve basis

Fast Track

- Covers tuition only for the summer semester following graduation
- Open to all Navajo and Apache county current year high school graduates and homeschooled graduates registering for the summer semester
- Must submit proof of graduation to the NPC Financial Aid Office located in Holbrook.
- Submit all documents at the time of registration

Counselor's Choice

- Covers 13 credits per semester for 4 consecutive semesters (Tuition Only)

- Must be a high school graduate by the May of the current year or by the end of the current school year.
- Each high school nominates up to 3 students
- Must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher at the end of each semester
- Must be degree-seeking at NPC
- Only high school guidance counselors may nominate a graduating senior for this scholarship, students cannot apply directly.

President's Scholar

- \$2,200 per semester for 4 semesters – covers tuition, fees, and books (whatever is left over will be disbursed to the student)
- Must have graduated with a 3.5 GPA or better from a Navajo or Apache county high school
- 12 awarded per year
- Maintain a 3.25 cumulative GPA while at NPC
- Must be degree seeking at NPC
- Must enroll in the one credit Honors Colloquia each semester

Finish Line

- Covers tuition only of the last 12 credits of student's NPC degree
- Must be degree seeking at NPC
- High school diploma or GED
- Must be eligible for in-state tuition
- Must have current: FAFSA, NPC Financial Aid Information Sheet, and NPC Degree Audit (obtained from an academic advisor)

Student Ambassador

- \$500/semester
- Must commit to one academic year (Fall and Spring Semesters)
- Be enrolled in 12 or more credits each semester
- Maintain a 2.5 GPA at the end of each semester
- Must be degree seeking
- Based on participation of 40 documented & approved hours each semester. This equates to 2.5 hours of service a week!

Text Book

- Covers the cost of textbooks/books
- Must be enrolled for 6 or more credits at NPC
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher at NPC
- Degree seeking at NPC
- High school diploma required – does not apply to current high school students
- Need based scholarship

Lumberjack Scholarship- Covers up to 100% of tuition. Must meet or be in progress to complete the 16 college prep courses with a 3.5 and no letter grade lower than a B. You must be an Arizona resident.

Presidents Scholarship- \$7000 per academic year. Selection based on 3.5 4.0 high school GPA and test scores at least ACT 19/SAT 900 combined taken before March 2018. Arizona residents only. To renew must maintain a 3.0 at NAU.

Deans tuition scholarship- \$4000 per academic year, 3.0-3.49, ACT19/SAT900, Arizona residents only. Renewable with a 2.75_ *November 15th, 2017- for FAFSA priority completion

AIR FORCE ROTC SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY: Seniors who are US citizens

(or will be by the start of your first semester in college), will graduate in May of 2018, at least 17 years of age within the first semester of the year you will enter college. Min GPA of 3.0 (end of junior year) Min SAT score of 1270 (reading/math) or ACT composite score of at least 26.

You MUST complete an online application including a personal statement and interview. Applying does not obligate you in any way. As a scholarship recipient though you obligate yourself when you sign an agreement with the U.S. Air Force. If you are under legal age in the state where the school is located, your parent or legal guardian signs this agreement. You then agree to:

Enroll the academic major in which the scholarship is offered

Enlist in the Air Force Reserve and enroll in the Air FORCE ROTC beginning the fall 2018 semester.

Complete a four week summer field training course at an air force base (normally scheduled between sophomore and junior year.

Complete the Air force ROTC professional officer Course

Accept a commission as Air Force officer

Serve at least four years on active duty
