* School attendance is not only a good habit, state law requires it. Arizona State Law (ARS 15-802(A), ARS 15- 803(E)) and Governing Board Policies (JE, JH) requires every person who has custody of a child between the ages of six and sixteen years shall make sure the child attends school for the full time school is in session. Parents/Guardians must notify the school in advance or at the time of the absence.

*Please have your child to school on time and, if at all possible, please do not check them out early. Our students transfer classes M-TH from 2:00-2:30 making late check-outs difficult for your child and their teacher. It is extremely important that your child be here all day on Fridays which are our test days.
