EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

The superintendent or designee is authorized to close, dismiss, or evacuate schools in the event of hazardous weather or any emergency or disaster which may threaten the health or safety of students and personnel.

The District, in cooperation with state and local agencies, will maintain emergency and disaster operating plans designed to protect the safety of students and staff in the event of natural and man-made disasters and to provide for safety measures during resulting school emergencies. These plans are contained in the Emergency Procedures Manual and shall be reviewed annually on or before September 1st, and updated in coordination with guidelines of the Department of Homeland Security, local law enforcement agencies, and the local fire department. Copies of the Emergency Procedures Manual will be available to all District personnel.

Each year, all Park 6 employees will be required to complete the Safe Schools training module on the Emergency Procedures Manual. It is the responsibility of all personnel to be familiar with the guidelines and be prepared to activate procedures when necessary. Any questions regarding the plans should be directed to the building principal or the employee's immediate supervisor.
