- Girls and Boys Track
- Volleyball
- Wrestling
- Girls and Boys Swimming

State champions, individual all conference and individual all state in the following:

- Girls and Boys Alpine Skiing
- Girls and Boys Nordic Skiing
- Gymnastics

Non-athletic

- Drama; 1st place, individual or group event
- Journalism; 1st place, individual category or paper
- Yearbook; 1st place, individual category or yearbook
- Speech; state champion and individual 1st place
- Student Council; outstanding state council and individual state officership
- FBLA; state chapter of the year and individual Mr. and Ms. FBLA
- Cheerleaders; state champion
- FFA;
- Band; state champion and individual all state
- Choir; state level group recognition and individual all state

Academic: significant individual awards to be considered on a case-by-case basis, i.e.,

- National Merit Scholar

Personnel: significant individual awards to be considered on a case-by-case basis, i.e.,
