**CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT, ADOPTION AND REVIEW**

Constant adaptation and development of the curriculum is necessary if the district is to meet the needs of the children in its schools. In order to meet that mission, the Board expects the administration and faculty to evaluate programs to see that they meet the needs of students and to undertake curriculum evaluation and revision to design courses of study.

The Board of Trustees authorizes a Curriculum Coordinating Council (CCC) and grants it the authority to make professional recommendations to the Board pertaining to curriculum, instruction, assessment and student learning.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for providing the leadership necessary to develop a district-wide curriculum, and for working directly with administrators and teachers. The Board of Trustees may, in its discretion, appoint an administrator who shall be directly responsible for the school district curriculum who shall report to the Superintendent.

The Board will hear regular reports on curriculum study and revision. It shall consider recommendations from the CCC for intensive curriculum study and may authorize the establishment of subject area committees (SAC) to work on particular areas. The Board shall also be receptive to the desires of parents and students in considering changes in the curriculum.

The addition, elimination of, or extensive alteration of courses of study, after review by the administration, shall be subject to Board approval.

All teachers have professional obligations to the school program beyond regular classroom duties, and these duties shall include work on curriculum committees. It is expected that all teachers will make a contribution to this work.
