**COMBINATION SCHOOL CHECKLIST**

The following list is compiled to prepare the WHSAA Affiliate Home School member for possible issues that will need to be addressed pursuant to entering into a combination school agreement.

\_\_\_\_\_ Inquire of member school concerning the possibilities of entering into a combination school agreement. This is best done with a phone call to the administration of that school. They can best tell you how and if this can be accomplished and the procedure. Remember that each local school district is free to set its own policy concerning combination school agreements.

\_\_\_\_\_ If the member school you contact is agreeable to consider your request for a combination school, be prepared to address any and/or all of the following issues:

1. Charge to you of the expenses per student that it costs that school to sponsor said activity.
2. Contract of agreement. This would include both the WHSAA Combination School Agreement (A1) and a contract of agreement with the host school.
3. Academic eligibility and proof of as per host school and WHSAA rules & regulations.
4. Travel to and from practices and contests.
5. Physical examinations as per WHSAA and host school rules.
6. Behavior expectations as per host school Code of Conduct and sport specific training rules and consequences.
7. Proof of medical insurance (other than WHSAA Catastrophic Insurance).
8. Proof of registration a Affiliate Member School of the WHSAA.
9. Registration to meet the statutory requirements of the State of Wyoming.
10. Practice times and trips for contests, especially those involving any loss of school time.
11. Assumption of risk issues.
12. Making the team when a limited number of positions are available to students.
13. Other issues may include but are not limited to school attendance, activity philosophy, supervision, conduct at events, activity schedule, practice attendance, transferring schools, awards, etc.
