ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT/PROGRESS REPORTS

The Board believes that children have diverse capabilities and individual patterns of growth and learning. Therefore, it is important that teachers have as much accurate knowledge of students as possible in order to determine their educational needs and make instructional plans for them. Sharing of information among parent, teacher, and student is essential.

Notification to parents of the academic achievement of students is essential in order to get the parents involved in the academic achievement of their children. Two procedures are utilized in notification of parents regarding academic achievement. Periodic progress reports will be sent home. This will generally occur at the end of each nine-week period or at the parent conference. Formal and informal parent conferences will also provide information to parents regarding each student's academic progress.

Parents should normally be contacted before the official conference period or at the end of the reporting period if their child is having behavior or academic problems.

The Board supports staff efforts to find better ways to measure and report student progress.
