GRADUATION EXERCISES/VALEDICTORIAN AND SALUTATORIAN

The Board believes that graduation exercises are an important part of the total school program. Therefore, the high school principal and staff shall plan suitable culmination activities for those graduating from high school. All district faculty are encouraged to attend.

The Board chairman or other person designated by the Board shall present diplomas at graduation or shall give this honor to a member who has a son or daughter graduating.

PARTICIPATION IN GRADUATION EXERCISES

All students who have successfully completed the requirements set by the Board of Trustees and are in good standing may participate in the graduation exercises.

The principal of the high school is authorized to withhold participation privileges in the graduation exercises and other graduation activities for good cause. The principal, upon withholding the participation privileges, shall make an immediate and complete report to the Superintendent.

VALEDICTORIAN AND SALUTATORIAN

In order to be eligible for valedictorian and salutatorian honors, a student must be a full time student and be enrolled during the three trimesters immediately preceding graduation. In addition, the final 7.5 credits earned prior to graduation, must be earned as a student of Cody High School. Students who choose to graduate early will not be eligible for valedictorian or salutatorian.
