Re: P.E. Clothes

We wanted to clarify the policy at John Muir Middle School regarding P.E. clothes for students.

The following is longstanding practice at John Muir Middle School, but we are sending it out to parents in writing to clear up any possible misconceptions.

Students in 6th grade P.E. have a less strenuous class and are not required to dress out.

Students in 7th and 8th grade P.E. need to dress out in proper clothing.

Parents of 7th and 8th grade students must select from the following three options regarding P.E. clothes:

1. Purchase a P.E. Uniform (Shorts and T-Shirt) for \$18.00. (Students can keep and reuse these.)
2. Get year-long loaner clothes from a P.E. Teacher (These must be returned at the end of the year.)
3. Bring plain solid black shorts and a plain solid gray t-shirt. The t-shirt and shorts may not have any logos, stripes, or decorations. Additionally, the shorts may not have pockets of any kind.

When it is cold, students are permitted to wear sweatpants and sweatshirts – they cannot be red or blue and must otherwise meet school dress code requirements. In addition, when wearing sweatpants and sweatshirts, students are required to wear their P.E. clothes under their sweatpants or sweatshirts.
