ELA: Students continue to learn about different text structures in the nonfiction unit. We have learned about main idea and supporting details, cause and effect, and argumentative text. We will be learning about problem and solution, chronological order, and compare and contrast. In language arts students are continuing to learn about capitalization and punctuation. In December students will concentrate on titles, the colon and semicolon, abbreviations, and apostrophes. Currently, students should have mastered capitalizing proper nouns, placing the correct end marks at the end of sentences, and quotes.

SOCIAL STUDIES: Our scholars are keeping busy in Social Studies class. We have completed our first unit and test for the US Constitution...The Executive Branch. Scholars took their test on December 8th & 9th and the results were OUTSTANDING! Our next Constitution unit and test will be the Preamble followed by the Amendments. The Legislative Branch, and finally the Judicial Branch. All 5 tests will be averaged for a final Constitution Test Score. This average must be 60% or higher to pass. All units and tests, including the IL Constitution should be complete by the end of the 3rd Quarter.
