Dear Seligman Parents/Guardians,

The Governing Board and I have determined that it is in the best interests of the safety and wellbeing of our students and staff for **Seligman Schools to be closed on Thursday, November 19, 2020.**

This letter is to inform you that a student or staff member at our school who had possible Covid19 exposure, has had a positive test result. Immediate action is being taken to follow extra safety precautions. Nothing is more important to us than the safety of all of our Antelopes!

During the closure our schools will continue to be deeply cleaned and disinfected in all areas including athletic equipment for sports. All sports practices will be cancelled for the remainder of this week and during the Thanksgiving Break. We are continuing to monitor the situation and are working closely with our local health department.

Next week is our Thanksgiving Break from November 23-26, 2020. At this time, we expect to resume school in-person on Monday, November 30 as students and staff return from Thanksgiving Break.

With the health and safety of students and staff members at Seligman Schools being a priority, please continue to follow CDC Guidelines and adhere to State and Local Orders. If your child develops any symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (cough, shortness of breath, fever, fatigue, muscle or body aches, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea), immediately call your doctor and let them know about your child's exposure and symptoms so that they can tell you what to do next.
