To the Parents of Seligman Schools,

Today Governor Ducey announced the extension of school closures through the end of the school year.

Parents, thank you for responding to the Antelope Technology Survey.

Teachers will be making contact with you by phone or email with specific information that you need to know about your student’s education assignments during this closure.

Starting Tuesday, March 31 your student’s lessons will be delivered either by teacher email, by Seligman School District vehicle at bus stops or at the district office. You will see the transportation schedule posted on the district website, Facebook and through teachers’ emails. Lessons picked up at the District will be available Mondays and Wednesday from 10:00 A.M.-11:00 A.M .

For our Peach Springs students, Hualapai Education Department have informed us that they will pick up student instructional packets at the Caverns for parents to pick up at the Tribal Education Training Center

Until the end of the school year “Grab and Go” sack meals will be offered at the Seligman School District Monday through Thursday from 10am-11am. For those parents who have requested meals for their students at the bus stop, meal distribution will be at your regular bus stop on Mondays and Wednesdays. PLEASE CHECK WEBSITE FOR DISTRIBUTION TIMES. Transportation provided meals are 2 breakfast/2 lunch sacks.

Things you (and your child) can do to support your child’s curriculum (at any time, not just during a quarantine).

Read every day. For an hour at least. All of you. Read together. Read quietly and alone. Think about what you read. Talk about it. Write about it. Also please devote time every day to work some math problems that have been assigned.

If students are reading, writing and working on solving math problems every day then we feel that our students will not lose ground in basic skills during the school closure.
