

Seligman Schools Mitigation Plans

Seligman Schools will welcome students back to campus, in-person in the future as soon as we are allowed to open. At this time we are awaiting for guidance from the Arizona Health Department on what is needed to reopen school. The district will be implementing the following preventative protocols and making modifications to prioritize student and staff safety. Face Covering and masks we are waiting for direction from the Arizona Health Department and the Arizona School Board Association recommended policies that will be going to our local School Board for policy for guidance and direction.

Buses

- Parents must wait at the bus stop until students are screened. Students who are left unattended will be issued a bus violation.
- Students must pass a temperature check (no higher than 100.4 degrees) and a visual screening (shortness of breath, chills, cough, congestion, runny nose, vomiting etc.)
- Siblings will sit together.
- Masks are highly recommended on buses. It is recommended that students have their own masks. Disposable masks are available for students who don't have one.
- Students will be given hand sanitizer before entering the bus.
- Parents of bus riders who live in district may opt to transport their own students to campus. There is mileage reimbursement available for families who live more than 1 mile from campus.

Drop Off

- When arriving at school please stay in the vehicle. Signs will be posted to give directions to follow. The student will remain in their vehicle to be screened.
- A school staff member will check all temperatures and screen before students exit the vehicle
- Any student with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher will not be permitted to enter campus.
- Staff will give all individuals that enter campus at the outdoor screening center hand sanitizer and a mask if needed.

Walk In

- All students must be with a guardian when walking onto campus if they are under 18 years of age.

- A school staff member will check all temperatures and screen before students are allowed to enter the campus at the outdoor screening center will be given hand sanitizer and given a mask if needed.

Breakfast and Lunch

- Students will be allowed to use the cafeteria for breakfast and lunch.
- The breakfast “grab and go” option is available. This option is located outdoors near the elementary school.
- Some seating will be marked unavailable in the cafeteria to assist with social distancing.
- Elementary students will be grouped at tables by grade.
- Middle School students may opt to eat outside at the outside tables provided.
- High School Students should utilize the student lounge or outside tables to eat to avoid crowds.
- High school is temporarily restricted from leaving campus at lunchtime.
- Any student, who wants to leave campus at any time, needs to be checked out by a parent or guardian.
- The gym will not be available for any students during lunches.

Nurse’s Office

- Isolation rooms will be built in the nurse’s office
- Staff will receive guidance from nurse regarding changes to the nurse’s office
- Staff will call nurse before sending any student.
- Students will receive guidance from the nurse during Antelope Academy regarding new nurse’s office procedures and hand washing protocol.

Technology

- Computers for 8-12 will be picked up in the library. No student will touch the cart or cords at any time. Staff will hand each student their device.
- Computer for grades 6-7 will be picked up in the resource room. No student will touch the cart or cords at any time. Staff will hand each student their device.
- All computers will be dropped off in the same room that they were picked up from. No student will touch the cart or cords at any time. All devices will be placed on a table.
- Devices will be sanitized and recharged by staff daily.

Classrooms

- Classrooms are cleaned and sanitized regularly throughout the day and after school.
- Students will use hand sanitizer upon entering a classroom.
- Cases of water will be available in each classroom.
- Classroom are organized to give the most social distancing as possible.

Restroom

- Only 2 students at any one time will be allowed to use the restroom.
- Students will be required to wash their hands with soap for 20 seconds.
- Students will use hand sanitizer when reentering the classroom.
- Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized on a regular basis during and after the school day.

Recess

- Before school recess is cancelled until further notice. Students will report to their classrooms.
- Morning recess will be staggered (K-1, 2-3, 4-5) Face coverings or masks are not needed on the playground for this activity.
- Only permitted areas of the playground will be used per each group. That area of the playground equipment that was used by the students will be sanitized after each use.
- Lunch recess will utilize a sectioning method. Each group will be permitted on one section of the playground only for that afternoon. Classes can rotate sections. Classes will stagger the time the return to the building to avoid crowding in the bathrooms.

P.E. / Health

- P.E. will be held outside as much as possible.
- Middle School Health will be held in the gym to meet social distancing guidelines.
- P.E. class will be well structured and curriculum will focus on calisthenics, games, and activities that do not need shared equipment in the 1st quarter. Quarter 2 TBD later.

Library

- Library will have signs instructing users to place any books they have touched into a bin.
- Library staff will sanitize computers and high touch surfaces after each use.
- The library will be allowing small groups or classes to attending meeting social distancing guidelines.

Drinking Fountains

- Only the water bottle filling stations will be open and social distancing will be followed while waiting for water.
- Students should bring their own reusable water bottles with their names on them.
- Cases of water will be available in each classroom.

Assemblies

- Assemblies will only be for individual schools (all three schools will not gather for an assembly). Social Distancing will be used by each school in the gym by grade.

Field Trips

- All field trips are cancelled until further notice.
- Virtual field trips are being recommended at this time

Visitors/ Volunteers

- Only necessary visitors will be permitted.
- Volunteers and visitors must pass the same screening process and face covering as students and staff.
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Dismissal

- Elementary students will be released a few minutes early in a staggered format to limit the interaction with older students.
- Middle School students will be dismissed after the elementary students.
- High school students will be dismissed at the final bell at 3:40pm.

ALL STAFF

- All staff must pass the temperature check and self-monitor their health before entering the school.
- All staff are to use appropriate social distancing when possible in their work environment.
- If staff do not feel well, they are to stay home and inform their immediate supervisor.

In Case of Teacher Illness

- If the teachers does not feel well they are to remain at home and inform their principal.
- When the teacher returns to school, they are to self-screen to come back to work.
- Teachers are required to be a week ahead in lesson planning and material preparation. Lesson plans for the following week are required to be submitted to the superintendent by 8am on Monday.
- Teachers are required to have an emergency sub folder. A list of necessary components will be provided.
- Every teacher will utilize a buddy teacher who understands where materials and things are kept in your room in case of your absence.
- Sub plans must include a written plan with detailed explanations. You need to provide subs with an up to date class list.

In Case of Classified Illness

- If staff do not feel well, they are to stay home and inform their immediate supervisor.
- When staff returns to work, they must self-screen to come back to work.
