As of right now, I have both packets that can be picked up at the school with these same assignments available online through google classroom. The packets are for two weeks and I will post online on a weekly basis. If you responded to the survey and are in need of a chromebook, you should be getting information this week. This is a new process for myself and I'm sure there will be some hiccups, but I'm hoping it will go as smoothly as possible. Most of the material I have included is work that we have done throughout the year on some level, except for history where we were in the middle of a unit on Rome. I have included some video sites through Ted-Ed and Kahn Academy in my lesson plans as well. The work that will be on google classroom or through the packet will be on a weekly basis, so the students can pick and choose what they complete daily. The lesson plans I have included show a daily breakdown that might help with time management and further details for assignments

If the students are using a personal computer or even the school chromebooks, they may need to login to clever to see google classroom, i-station, etc. These are the steps:

1. Go to clever.com
2. Go to the top right hand corner that says "login as a student"
3. When it says search for school, find Palominas and click on it.
4. Click login and type your student email address
5. Enter the student password
6. Once the student is logged in they should have access to everything
