Tier 2 Planning...Just in Case!

We have successfully completed thirteen weeks of full-time in-person instruction, also referred to as Tier I. During this time, our students have adapted to the new safety protocols and are making tremendous strides in their academic growth. While we celebrate our progress thus far, we need to be ready to transition to a different tier – Tier II or Tier III – should covid-19 prevalence rates require us to do so. We want to notify you of our plans well in advance so that you have sufficient time to make necessary plans.

Under Tier II, identified students will be expected to attend brick and mortar school, and those students/families will be notified. The majority of our students will attend school remotely. Students will have access to video lessons, live Zoom, office hours, and email as communication to work with teachers each day. Attendance – either in-person or remote – will be mandatory for all students Monday through Thursday. On Friday's, teachers will schedule students identified as needing additional instruction and support in-person or remotely.

We feel this schedule is best because it allows students to be able to access all classes every day, as opposed to every other day. We also are aware that, for some families, this schedule allows older siblings to assist with younger siblings. Although we all realize remote instruction is not as powerful as in-person instruction, we do feel we have prepared the students to be successful remotely through the use of Canvas, Zoom, and other online tools.

Again, please remember this message is strictly for communication purposes. We will continue to communicate to parents and guardians as our plans develop. Our goal, as it has been from the beginning of the school year, is to keep our school open and to keep students learning in-person with their teachers. We just need to be ready in case that option is not available to us in the future. Thank you for your support.

Computer Care and Communication: As the weather changes, we would like to have students take extra care with the computers. The computer is sensitive to the elements and needs extra care when it is cold. When the computer is cold, it is **important to let the computer warm up to room temperature before using**. We will be talking to the students about this process at school; parents, please reinforce it at home.

Parent Email Address Updates: As a school, we are looking for ways to better communicate with our parents and students. We will be emailing our students periodically to inform them of things that they need to be aware of. The students will be asked to share some emails with parents to help facilitate school-to-home communications. Additionally, our school newsletter and calendar will be emailed to students, parents, and staff each month. Opportunity Room/ICU Database: Our program will help us to communicate more efficiently with parents in regards to your child's daily assignments. When a teacher enters your child into the ICU program for a missing assignment, parents will instantly be notified by text and/or email and will also be notified once the assignment has been completed. The program currently sends out a maximum of two emails and one text message per student. Please keep the school updated on any phone or email changes.

CANVAS Learning Management System: Our students use the CANVAS Learning Management System (LMS) to access their class information, grades and assignments. If for some reason you need any assistance with the CANVAS system, please contact Mr. Zac Opps at ZTOpps@pcsd1.org.

Student Lunch Account Access

Parents, did you know you can **access your student's lunch account** through **Infinite Campus**? You can also pay for any **fines** your student has.

(First time users: You will need to contact your child's school to get an Infinite Campus Portal Activation Key. This number is needed to associate you with your student and will be used to create your account.)

Established users sign in with your username and password. Forgot your username or password? If your user preferences were previously set-up, you can click on "forgot your password" or "forgot your username" to begin the process of recovering them.

- Step 1: Using the link https://pcsd1.infinitecampus.org/campus/portal/park.jsp, log on to the Infinite Campus Parent Portal.
- Step 2: Click on Fees in the left-hand corner.
- Step 3: From this point, follow the directions to navigate through the Infinite Campus Parent Portal. If you need clarification, please call the Middle School at 764-6185 and we would be happy to email you more detailed instructions.
