

## **BUSINESS AND NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS**

### **Gifts, Grants, and Bequests**

The Board may accept on behalf of and for the school district any bequest or gift of money or property for a purpose deemed by the Board to be suitable, and to utilize such money or property so designated.

The Superintendent of Schools shall set up criteria to be met in the acceptance of gifts, and the procedure for examining and evaluating offers or gifts to the district.

Acceptance of gifts must be made at a regular or special board meeting by a majority vote of the members present. These gifts become the property of the school district and decisions about the utilization and disposition of said gifts shall be made by the Board of Education.

Some memorials, grants, bequests, and gifts of a specific nature where a scholarship or specific use of the money is desired may be recommended to the Springfield Platteview Community Schools Foundation.
