Tues. Sept 1	4:30 & 6:30	JV & V Softball	Duchesne @ Dill Softball Complex	<p>We are not allowing student fans to attend any sporting events (home or away) in the River Cities Conference. For our outdoor venue at Dill Softball Complex, we will allow up to 4 immediate family members for each player on the roster. They are not transferable, meaning if one player only brings 2 it does not allow another to bring 6. I will be at the gate taking count of family members per player. Players should bring their own water. Dill runs the concessions and I believe they plan to have them open. Please also pass the following requests on to your coach. We're going to be overly strict in the hopes of keeping our players on the field all season. Thanks!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Wear masks upon entry. -Please have exact change (or check made out to Duchesne Academy) \$5 adults, \$3 Kids K-12. -Only passes accepted are RCC Conference passes and Duchesne Booster passes. -Please plan to bring your own lawn chairs. -Sit with your immediate families spaced out at least 6 feet from other families. At that point, you can take your mask off.
Tues. Sept 1	5:30	Jr High Cross Country	Plattsmouth Middle @ Rylander Park, Plattsmouth	The city park doesn't have an ordinance, but we are recommending spectators to have a mask with them and wear when they can't social distance.
Wed. Sept 2	4:30	Girls Golf	Platteview Country Club	Mask-recommended in the clubhouse area, along with social distancing.
Thurs. Sept 3	11:00	Girls Golf	Bellevue East @ Tara Hills Golf Course	Temporarily - NO METRO passes accepted. Attendance will be limited to family members participating in the event and essential event personnel. Each participant's family will be given a purchasing permit to purchase up to 4 tickets for both outdoor and indoor events. Home and Away.
Thurs. Sept 3	5:00 & 6:30	JV & V Softball	Ralston	Wager Field (2 blocks east of 84th and Park Drive). As fans enter the ticket area they will say which roster member they are associated with and must purchase all tickets associated with that player at once (up to four). Once those tickets are purchased, that name on the roster will be crossed off and no other tickets can be sold using that name. Visiting fans can sit in family groups but must social distance from others. We ask all fans to wear masks during the game. It is highly recommended that fans bring their own chairs and spread out around the complex. There will be very limited seating in the stands. There will not be concessions at this game. Restrooms will be available.
Thurs. Sept 3	5:00, 6:00, 7:00	R, JV, & V Volleyball	Ralston	Platteview will have the bench area to the right of the score table as you face it. Your fans will sit on the west side bleachers which is opposite of the two teams. All spectators will be required to wear masks. The opposing team will send a roster and that roster will be used to allow for the purchase of the actual game tickets. As fans enter the ticket area they will say which roster member they are associated with and must purchase all tickets associated with that player at once (up to four). Once those tickets are purchased, that name on the roster will be crossed off and no other tickets can be sold using that name. Visiting fans can sit in family groups but must social distance from others. We ask all fans to wear masks during the game. Ralston will use every other row for seating. There will be plenty of seats. Student sections are not allowed. There will be concessions for this game. We ask that fans social distance when in line at concessions.

Sept. 4	9:00	Jr High and Varsity Cross Country	Johnson County Central @ Tecumseh Country Club	<p>Please assist us by reminding your fans and athletes to stay off the greens and out of the clubhouse. The Jr. High (grades 7 & 8) Fun Run will begin at 9:00 a.m. The race will be approximately 2500 meters in length. The girls' varsity race will begin at 9:30 a.m. with the boys' varsity race following at approximately 10:15 a.m. The JV girls and boys race will begin at approximately 10:30 a.m. We are planning on running the girls and boys JV races at the same time, unless the number of runners dictates otherwise. Spectators should wear a mask when they are unable to socially distance. Spectators are not allowed near the finish line or FAT tent. No individual who has been asked to quarantine by state or local authorities should attend the meet if the quarantine is in place for September 4. The clubhouse will have limited access to those wishing to make a purchase. Anyone entering the clubhouse will need to wear a mask and practice social distancing. All participants and spectators should use the portable toilets located west of the clubhouse. Parking is limited to the parking lot. There should be no vehicles parked on the course. Please remind your coaches, athletes, and parents to stay off the greens on the golf course and to pick up your area after the meet is over.</p>
