We ask that masks be worn by players, coaches, and spectators when 6 ft. of social distancing can't take place.

All times are after the first race are approximate.:4:00 pm - Girls Middle School. 4:20 pm - Boys Middle School. 4:40 pm - Girls Varsity and JV. 5:20 pm - Boys Varsity. 5:50 pm - Boys JV Fan parking is located at the entrance on the east side of the lake and will be marked. Wahoo Public Schools will now REQUIRE masks to be worn by ALL SPECTATORS at all Wahoo Public Schools Activities, while at home or at an away event. All spectators to be respectful of others and maintain social distancing and 6 ft. guidelines as set by the CDC and local health departments. LVMS staff members will check off family names upon entering. No students allowed unless immediate family of a player or coaches. Spectators must wear a mask at all times. Spectators are reminded to maintain social distancing before, during, and after the game. Home team fans must socially distance in the home section while visitors must do the same in the visitor section. No concessions
THURS. SEPT 10	4:15	JR HIGH VOLLEYBALL	BLAIR (A)	The game will be played at Otte Middle School. The Otte Middle School bleachers are small and indoor capacity from the Three Rivers Health Department is currently at 50%. Because of these restrictions, attendance is limited to immediate family, parents, grandparents and siblings, of competitors from each team. A list will be checked at the entrance and temperatures will be screened. Please STAY HOME if you are ill. Cost is \$3 for adults and \$2 for youth (all need to be on the pass list) Family groups will be expected to social distance from other family groups in the stands. Masks are required for entry at all Blair Community Schools events. You must remain masked inside BCS facilities. Restrooms will be available for spectators but there will be no concessions.

THURS. SEPT 10	4:30	JV & V SOFTBALL	PLATTSMOUTH	Plattsmouth High School Baseball Field- 1916 Old Hwy. 34-Field is located at the north end of the school by the administration building. Spectator vehicles should park on the north side (front entrance) by administration building for easier access to the field. Spectators should wear face coverings as well. PHS stands are small and have limited capacity. The stands will be marked with tape indicating where spectators may sit. We are asking that immediate family members of players attend the game. This number should not exceed 3 in a group. We will try to sit people on the outside of the field in the outfield area and ask that they stay 6 ft. apart. No student sections will be allowed. We will have limited pre-packaged items for sale at our concession stand. We ask all coaches, players, and spectators to not congregate in the stands after the game. We ask that all parties involved go immediately to their vehicle and head home.
