- Applicants must have maintained a minimum GPA of 2.75.
- Applicants must have plans to pursue a career in a health or medical profession.
- Applicants must exemplify good citizenship through active involvement in school and community and solid academic achievement.
- The scholarship recipients must enroll at a post-secondary educational institution.
- Only applications received by the Counseling Center **on or before April 1st** will be reviewed and forwarded to the respective scholarship selection committee for consideration. **Any incomplete applications or applications that do not meet the requirements will be rejected.**
- 7th semester transcripts will be attached to the application by the high school counseling department.
