# **Student Verification**

## **Lunch Account Updates**

We are experiencing a glitch with our eFunds system, which is the program families can use to pay for lunches electronically. Due to these technical issues the eFunds program has been suspended and is not operational. Please do not try to use the eFunds system to pay for lunch until further notice.

# **Breakfast Is Served Everyday**

Any student who attends Springfield Elementary can eat breakfast at school from 7:45-8:05 (M 8:45-9:05). There are four options daily: two hot meals, cold cereal, or oatmeal. All breakfasts include the fruit bar and a milk. Students can purchase additional items, such as another milk (.60) or cold cereal (.50) for an additional charge.

# Pick up and Drop Off

We appreciate all the parents, grandparents, daycare providers, etc. for all the support and help during drop off and pick up over the first week. We needed to make adjustments with the increase in the number of students. Each grade level has an assigned spot to line up in the morning and dismiss from at the end of the day.
