### <<< COWBOY LEARNING SUPPORT PROGRAM, K-12 >>>

**Eligibility:**

- Must be enrolled in Willcox Elementary, Middle or High School
- Unable to participate in At Home Learning due to a hardship
- Complete screening interview with site principal

**Location:** Grades K-4 – Elementary School, Grades 5-8- Middle School, & Grades 9-12 – High School

**Days & Time:** Monday-Thursday, 8:00am-3:30pm

**Cost:** No fees

- Supervision and support provided by instructional staff
- Maintain a 15:1 student to staff ratio or less
- Students will receive the same instruction as those who are participating in At Home Learning
  - Chromebook provided
  - English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies and Specials (6-8)
  - Semester (1) courses including electives (9-12)
  - Google Classroom/Edgenuity/Schoology/etc.

**Parent responsibilities:**

- 1) Schedule screening interview
- 2) Fill out registration form to attend
- 3) Provide transportation to and from facility
- 4) Monitor student for fever and other listed health symptoms
- 5) Only bring child to facility if free of fever for 72 hours without the use of fever reducing medication

**Personnel responsibilities:**

- 1) Daily temperature check
- 2) Stay home if experiencing any listed health symptoms
- 3) Face coverings required when unable to maintain social distancing

**Breakfast & Lunch:** Available for purchase; meal pricing determined by your 2020-2021 free and reduced meal status

- Breakfast: K-6 \$2.00, 7-8 \$2.25, 9-12 \$3.00
- Reduced-Price Breakfast: \$.30
- Lunch: K-6 \$2.50, 7-8 \$3.05, 9-12 \$3.25
- Reduced-Price Lunch: \$.40
