Dear Parents and Caregivers:

We have learned that students and staff may have been exposed to a person with COVID-19 while at Willcox High School on or around September 14, 2020. We understand that this news may cause you concern. Willcox Unified School District is committed to implementing measures to protect attendees and staff from exposure to COVID-19, and to make sure you have all the information you need to make informed decisions about your health. We are working closely with the Cochise County Health Department who is conducting contact tracing and notifying contacts they need to isolate. As of this evening, the Cochise County Investigations Team has notified all potential contacts.

What do I do next?

Monitor your symptoms and those of anyone who lives in your home. It takes between 2-14 days for symptoms to show, but you may be contagious before then. You may be contagious even if you never get symptoms.

Regardless of how you feel, it is important that you continue to monitor yourself for symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

Continue to wear a facemask and wash your hands frequently.

Families and students: If you develop any symptoms, please let us know and do not come to school.

If you develop symptoms see your healthcare provider and/or get tested with a PCR test (nose swab or spit sample). This test determines if you are infected with the virus that causes COVID-19. If you are not sure where to go to be tested, please call 2-1-1 for more information.

Willcox Unified School District is following all recommendations from the Cochise County Health Department to slow COVID-19 from spreading in our school. This includes reminding staff and students to stay home when they are sick.
