My name is Mrs. Virginia Coleman. I am the Principal/Director of Curriculum and Instruction. I am so excited to be here!

I have been working hard putting together a plan to increase student achievement, raise expectations for all our students and bring Jeddito Elementary School into the spotlight. I hope you are as excited as I am for this school year!

I have been in public education since 2000. I started teaching in Parker, Arizona. I earned my first Master's Degree in 2003. I finished my administrative certification in 2016 and earned my Superintendent's Certificate in June, 2019.

I have a background in successfully moving students from far below proficient to meeting or exceeding proficiency. The key to helping students be successful is using data to drive instruction, helping them to determine their own goals and challenge themselves to master standards and objectives.

I don't want to put a lot of emphasis on standardized tests but when we have growth I think we need to acknowledge it.

Last year our students made some good progress moving from an overall 8% proficiency to 12% proficiency on the AZMERIT; for you math whizzes out there that is **a 150% improvement!**

This year we moved to a junior high format in our middle school, with all of our teachers focusing on one content area.

We have also removed the combo classes and hired staff for all grade levels. I believe that when we have high expectations for our children, when they understand what they are learning and why it's important, they are much more successful.

We will be hosting many after school events this year, designed to share our learning with families and the community, please come down and join us!

Parents and Guardians:

If you are going to request a BUS CHANGE, please either send a note or call before 2:00 pm. There are no guarantees for the bus change if a call is received after 2:00 pm.

If you send a note, tell your child to bring a note to the front office in the morning, so a bus change note will be issued to him/her to ensure they get on the right bus that is requested on the change.

Shower:

- Bring extra clothes
- Shampoo/Conditioner, body wash, and other hygiene stuff provided.
- Towels provided.



Laundry:

Students that qualify for McKinney Vento services are eligible to have clothes washed.

- One load a week, 5 pants, 5 tops, 5 under wear, 5 pairs of socks. Clothes must be the students.
- Multiple students from one household may do two (2) loads.
- Laundry has to brought in/tend to by parents.
