Pima Unified School District On-site Learning Plan

In accordance with the provisions of Executive Order 2020-51 public schools in Arizona are required to provide on-site learning opportunities for students where parents determine a need for such service is present.

Pima Unified School District performed a survey of parents and found more than 90% of parents felt on-site learning was needed by their children to achieve their academic goals. Based on this perspective and in face of the absence of a local outbreak that would justify not allowing children to congregate at school sites, Pima Schools are providing on-site instruction for all students.

Students who are unable or unwilling to attend have the opportunity to participate in their classes remotely through the distance learning program.

If the local public health officials determine a significant outbreak has occurred and it is no longer safe for some or all of students to attend school in a congregate setting, on-site instruction will be suspended for as long as they deem necessary.

Authority to establish this operational arrangement is based on action by the Pima USD Governing Board at the meeting held, August 13, 2020.
