# Procedures and Guidelines

- **PPE (personal protective equipment)**

  - All staff and students mandated to wear face shields

  - Students and staff may wear a disposable/cloth mask underneath face shield as well

- **Screenings: employee & students**

  - everyone will be screened

- **Sanitizing:** classrooms/bathrooms/drinking fountains/common areas/buses

  - Regular sanitizing throughout the day

- **Visitors on campus**

  - not allowed

  - only one person in the front office at a time (others will wait outside)

  - no forgotten lunches, uniforms, computers, homework will be taken

- **Common areas Closed**

  - Cafeteria

  - Library

  - Playground

- **Sports/clubs/field trips canceled during pandemic**

# CDC Guidelines for Schools

- Have same group of children stay with the same staff
- Restrict mixing between groups
- Limit gatherings, events, and extracurricular activities
- Restrict non essential visitors, volunteers, and activities involving other groups
- Desks should be 6 feet apart and when unable to do so, students must wear masks and/or desk shields
- Arrange desks so that they all face same direction
- Close communal areas such as cafeteria, Library, computer labs, and playgrounds
- Serve meals in the classroom
- Stagger arrival times and drop off times
- Sitting students one child per seat on the bus

# Classroom Set Up

- Face shield for everyone
- Students bring water bottles from home
- Teacher and student desks with desk shields (where permitted adequate spacing will be used)
- Students sitting in rows all facing same direction
- Students to not leave their class
- Teachers rotate to the classrooms
- Students eat in the classroom
- Recess
  - only one grade at a time for K-6<sup>th</sup>  
Playground use not allowed
  - 7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade a class in a half out on the field.

# Technology

- Chromebooks for every student
- WIFI available at the school

# Start of the school Year

- Week of August 3<sup>rd</sup> – starting with online instructions by classroom teachers contacting parents and offering online support
- Starting on **August 10<sup>th</sup>**, students will participate in remote learning **4 days a week from 8:00a.m. to 12:00p.m.** with their grade level teacher(s) and receive services through google classroom distant learning for the **first several weeks.**

### Kinder – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

Hybrid Cyclical Plan

**4 + 4 plan**

Students attend school for 4 days with staggered schedules to make sure only one student per seat on the bus

(Meals provided in the classroom)

The next 4 days the students learn from home with direct instruction from teachers with google classroom

**Option available:** Parents may choose 100% distant learning for the entire year using Mesa Distant Learning for grades 5th through 8<sup>th</sup> grade and Edgenuity for Kinder through 4<sup>th</sup> grade. This program requires parental support and is self paced.

# Grades and Special Services

## Kinder – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

A-F letter Grades will be issued

Students will be given two grades per subject per week based on tests, assignments, and participation.

## Special Services & Additional Instruction

Services such as gifted, Special Education, Title 1, and P.E.

These services will continue to be provided for all applicable students.

**The students will receive their services and/or instructional time at different times during their regular assigned school times within their classrooms and/or distant learning.**

# Attendance

Attendance will be taken daily and reported to the office

- No awards will be given for attendance during pandemic
- Attendance will be taken both in class instruction and during distance learning days

# School meals

- Students to continue to receive breakfast and lunches
- Meals will be delivered during distance learning times

You will be able to select if you would like to receive meals during distance learning days
