

Reopening of School



1. Can my child wear a facial mask and a face shield?

Yes, all children are required to wear face shields but they can also wear a face mask.

2. When will I know what supplies my child will need for school?

We will be mailing out a school supply list within the next two weeks. K-2nd grade will be using backpacks as usual and 3rd - 8th grade will use binders.

3. When will my child receive a Chromebook?

The Chromebooks have been ordered and will be getting to the school in August. Once the school receives them, they will need to be configured before being lend out to the students. In the meantime, we ask that students continue to use the devices they were using during the Spring. We will make every effort to get them out to you as soon as we can.

4. If I choose Distance learning through Mesa Distance Program for 5th - 8th or Edgenuity for Kinder - 4th grade will I still be a part of Little Red?

of course, Little Red is paying for your child to have a distance learning program as you choose and your child continues to be a Little Red Mustang.

5. If I choose the Distance Learning program for my child how will I be kept informed of Little Red events and news?

At this time all events, sports, field trips, and events are canceled due to the pandemic. You are able to log on to the school website www.sced28.com at any time for updates on our school. At any time, you are able to call the school for information as well.

6. How can my child socialize with their classmates?

If you choose the school hybrid model your child will be able to see classmates from a distance and will also be able to see classmates on google classroom during the weeks of distance learning.

If you choose the distance learning program due to the social distancing factor, your child will be able to interact with peers upon his/her return to school.

7. Why can't the school have a social media page for students/parents to interact?

Parents are welcome to use class Dojo, school web site, use the classrooms web page, and call the office for information. The school will call and send out texts if need be to give out information as necessary.

The school provides your child with a learning academic experience. Our top priority is educating your child.

We value the socializing part of your child's life as this is a big part of learning. However, COVID-19 has hit our community and the measures being taken are due to this pandemic. The school cannot be responsible for social media that could

turn out to be a negative impact for the students and the school. The school cannot act as a third party and breach parent confidentiality by giving out or being a liaison between parents. If you are wanting your child to socialize with others during this pandemic, we would suggest you contact your child's friend's parents and arrange the connections among yourselves. Please remember that not all parents want the same things for their children as learning comes first.

6. Can I choose to move my child from distance learning to the school learning model?

Yes, it was stated that you needed to commit to a full year of on line learning due to the fact that the school will be paying for the program; however, we understand that circumstances change and that this learning style might not be the best for your child; therefore, you may change at any time being considerate of the choice you have made.

7. At this time, is the school hybrid program the best solution?

The school will start with distance learning using google classroom in August and will continue until the middle of September. During this time your child will be learning from home along with his/her peers and with the classroom teacher doing all the teaching. They will be learning from 8a.m. to 12p.m. for about 6 weeks using this method before we go on to the hybrid combination model if it is allowed by the state. Our state is in constant change and we will have to wait to see what happens by then.

8. When will I receive my child's schedule for the distance learning at school?

For all students choosing the little Red distance learning for the first 6 weeks and the hybrid model afterwards, the schedules will be mailed out within the next two weeks.

If you are choosing the online only distance program, we will be calling you within the next few weeks to give you your username and passwords for the program and the program is self-paced. You are able to have your child log in at your leisure.

9. I am choosing to continue to stay with the Little red distance learning program for the first 6 weeks and then continue with the hybrid model but i work and i do not have someone to take care of my child, what can I do?

Please go ahead and call the school as we will make arrangements for your child to be at school during regular school hours with a staff member during the regular scheduled times of school from Monday - Thursday from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Your child will be able to be logged in and doing his work from school.

10. What if i do not have internet at home?

If you do not have internet at home, you are able to bring your child to school from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. from Monday through Thursday and your child can use the internet from school during these times.

11. Will my child be able to wash their hands regularly at school?

Yes, your child will be asked to wash their hands frequently and hand sanitizer will be available for their use.
