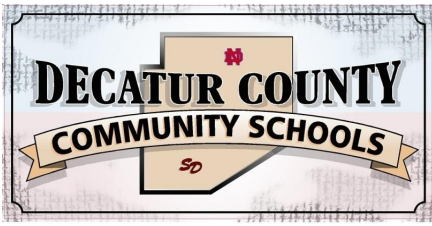


## Governor Holcomb's School Closure



Dear Decatur County Community Schools Families,

As I am sure most people have heard, Governor Holcomb closed all schools in Indiana through May 1<sup>st</sup> which will not allow for staff or students to enter our buildings. Decatur County Community Schools will continue its original plan of being closed for the two weeks of March 23-April 3<sup>rd</sup>, utilizing waiver days from the Governor. This means that no eLearning will take place for those weeks of March 23-April 3. As I stated previously, a decision on how school will proceed starting the week of April 6 will be announced to everyone by the end of March.

The Governor also delivered some amazing news that all state standardized testing has been waived for the remainder of the school year!

Please remember on Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> we will be distributing student electronic devices. We are keeping the same schedule announced earlier this week:

9:00-10:00 Kindergarten

10:00-11:00 1<sup>st</sup> grade

11:00-12:00 2<sup>nd</sup> grade

12:00-1:00 3<sup>rd</sup> grade-6<sup>th</sup> grade

Any Jr. /Sr. High parents that need to pick up their child's device will call the office between 9:00-12:00 to let administrators know they are coming to pick it up.

All devices will be handed to parents in their cars so no one is entering the schools. Any parent that cannot pick up a student device during these times needs to call the school's front office and confirm a time they can pick up the device later that day.
