West Oso ISD Campuses Return for In-Person Instruction  
on Monday, November 30, 2020

**EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY**

On Sunday, November 15, 2020, our offices were informed of a COVID-positive case and exposure of several employees to the virus. Based on recent updates regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and out of an abundance of caution, West Oso ISD made the decision to notify all parents via press release, robo-call and social media that ALL four campuses were transitioning to remote learning beginning Monday, November 16, 2020 until Friday, November 27, 2020. This timeline included the Thanksgiving Holidays scheduled for November 23-27, 2020.

The return date for all staff and students is Monday, November 30, 2020. Parents will be notified today via campus robo-call and social media about all campuses returning to in-person instruction regarding this return date. A press release will also be provided to local news stations regarding this notification.

West Oso ISD understands its shared responsibility to be diligent in preventative measures related to COVID-19 and in communicating with our school community. Our number one priority is the safety of our students, teachers, and families and we are committed to following the guidelines required by the CDC, local and state officials. As staff and students return on Monday, November 30, 2020, we will continue to monitor and follow all health and safety COVID-19 protocols. We encourage all WOISD staff, students and parents to follow these protocols and monitor themselves and their students closely for any sign of potential illness related to this virus.

We ask all parents, guardians and staff to continue monitoring the local tv stations, West Oso ISD website, and social media for any further updates or changes to this schedule.
