Dear West Oso ISD Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to the Bear Nation 2019-2020 School Year! As our football season gets underway, our goal at West Oso ISD is to create an environment that is safe, orderly, and encourages school spirit, camaraderie, pride, self-control, and responsibility among our students. We take this opportunity to inform you of the district's expectations with regard to student behavior during extra-curricular activities/events, specifically, football games played at Bear Stadium.

To help ensure the safety and enjoyment of all WOISD students, staff, parents, community members, and guests, the following guidelines continue to be in place for the 2019 Football Season:

- Upon arrival at the stadium, students who are NOT seated with their parents should locate their designated seating area (elementary, middle school, and high school) and remain there to enjoy the game.
- Students are required to stay in the stands unless they are going to the concession stand or restroom. Students will not be allowed to wander around the football stadium.
- Foul or inappropriate language or behavior towards staff or students will not be tolerated.
- NO footballs, volleyballs, skateboards and other sports equipment and materials will be allowed into the stadium. If these items are found or are being played with, they will be confiscated until the following Monday for parents to pick up at the campus.
- NO loitering will be allowed on sidewalks, handicap ramps, aisles, restrooms, and areas near the concession stands and the ticket booth. Students and others attending the game are to stay off the railings in front of the bleachers in order for fans to watch the game.
- No students will be allowed under the bleachers and the area behind the bleachers. This encourages horseplay and other types of inappropriate behavior that is unsafe.
- No loitering or students playing with footballs, water bottles, etc. will be allowed in the area in front of where buses and other vehicles are parked.
- Students seated in the top bleachers are restricted from throwing items such as bottles of water or other drinks (empty or full) onto the area behind the bleachers or on the sidewalks. This endangers those who are walking on the sidewalks behind the bleachers.
- Students will be expected to respond and comply appropriately when approached by game security and campus administrators for guideline violations.

Non-compliance with any of the above guidelines could result in students having to be seated with their parents or if no parent is present, in **immediate removal** and/or **suspension from future** extra-curricular activities.

We hope you will spend a few moments discussing this letter with your child(ren) to reinforce the expectations and rationale to help them understand that football games, as with all extra-curricular events, are considered WOISD school activities that are governed by district discipline management guidelines.

The West Oso ISD staff thanks all parents and students in advance for their cooperation and compliance with the expectations presented in this letter.
