



Medical Assisting Program Class & Orientation Information

COURSE OFFERED:

Clinical Medical Assisting (CMA) - 7 Month Program **\$2,070**

This course meets the guidelines required to sit for the Clinical portion of the State Certified Medical Assisting Examination or the CCMA (National Exam). Upon successful completion of this course, students will be issued a Certificate of Completion and a record of all injections and blood draws, permitting them to sit for the California Clinical Medical Assisting Exam and work as a Medical Assistant. Areas of Instruction will include Anatomy/Physiology, Medical Terminology, Pharmacology, Minor Surgery, Medical Records, Clinical Skills (Vital Signs, Injections, Capillary Puncture, EKGs, etc.), Medical Asepsis/Infection Control, Career Preparation and Nutrition. Rounding out this course, students will be CPR, AED and First Aid certified, issued by the American Red Cross.
