## **Supplies**

- One **red or blue** 3-ring, 1-inch binder
- One sturdy 3-hole punched, “free choice” homework folder (any color/design)
- Two, 1-subject notebooks (any color/design)
- One composition (marbled styled) notebooks
- One medium, snap-shut pencil box (around 8X6X2inches - **avoid large boxes**)
- **“Expo”** marker pack (darker colors are best)
- Three glue sticks
- Computer headphones
- One pair of small scissors
- Two boxes of #2, sharpened Ticonderoga pencils
- Pink eraser pack/pencil erasers
- One thin black “Flair”/felt pen
- “Sharpie” markers and a small box of colored sharpened colored pencils
- Computer stylus
- **Unscented** baby wipes
- Travel size tissues packs
- One extra face mask
- Water bottle with a **straw** attachment – no glass, please
- Personal pencil sharpener - small
- One blue pen

## **Supplies that are NOT needed**

- lined paper
- construction paper
