## KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST

Welcome to Kindergarten!

Here is a list of supplies we will need during the school year. Thank you for your assistance. Your child can bring these supplies to school on the first day. **Some of these supplies may need to be replenished throughout the year.**

\*Please clearly label ALL items with your child's name.

### In person school Supplies

- A Backpack (big enough to fit folder and lunchbox)
- (1)-Sturdy folder (bringing things back & forth to school)
- pencil box (to keep supplies in desk) (approx. 8" x 5")
- crayons (Twistables last the best)
- glue sticks
- colored pencils
- Markers
- highlighter
- safety scissors
- pencils (sharpened)
- larger extra eraser
- 2 dry erase markers
- travel tissues to keep in desk

- old clean sock (dry erase eraser)
- a pair of headphones (in a ziploc bag clearly labeled)
- **unscented** baby wipes
- a smock to keep in the classroom- labeled with name (can be an old adult shirt with sleeves trimmed)
- A reusable water bottle filled daily, with a straw to make it easier to drink and less spilling
- **Masks**- (1) to wear in school, (2) Additional face masks in a ziploc bag to be kept in backpack

**Suggested to keep in backpack**- (1) complete change of clothes (underwear, socks and pants and/or shorts) labeled in a ziploc bag (in case of accidents or spills), will need to change with the seasons

**Supplies to have on hand for Virtual learning:**

pencils, erasers, primary lined paper, dry erase markers, crayons, glue sticks, kid scissors, markers, colored pencils, highlighter, headphones
