How to Enroll

*Students under the age of 18 must have an exit interview from their previous high school or homeschool before enrolling.

Step 1: Complete and email the Online Registration Form

Step 2: Once we receive your registration, you will be contacted by a JCEC staff member. They will set you up on an online entrance test called the TABE Test. This is a “do your best” test and will be proctored remotely using Google Classroom. We will set up the test session and walk you through the process.

Step 3: Your TABE Test scores will be reviewed with you and you will be assigned an instructor.

Step 4: Your instructor will contact you and explain exactly how the online virtual learning will take place.
