I hope you've had a restful and fun-filled summer, and are now feeling ready to tackle a new school year. This summer, I spent a lot of time outside - I love running, biking, swimming, and taking my 3 dogs on walks. (That's all of them below!) I'm also just as happy sitting on the porch with a good book!

Although this is my first year at Hawlemont, I have eight years of experience as a school-based SLP. Prior to this year, I worked in North Adams with students ages 3 to 22 - from preschool all the way to the post-high school program!
