

Supply List for 6th Grade School Year 2020-2021

We will collect all items on the first day of school. Supplies will be labeled with the student's names and stored in the classroom to be used throughout the year. At the beginning of each quarter, we will refresh their pencil pouch with items from their supply.

- One 3 inch binder (We **STRONGLY** recommend a Zipper Binder that you can easily carry to each class)



- 3 packages of Notebook paper (1 for each homeroom teacher, we will pass it out in class when it's needed)
- 3 packages of note cards (3x5, lined, 100/pack)
- 1 package of Expo (or generic) dry erase markers
- 1 box of tissues (extras welcome!)
- 1 pack of five **pocket dividers** for binder (must have **POCKETS**)



- 1 pencil box (preferably a clear plastic one: it will be kept in the classroom with their extra supplies)
- Glue Sticks (4 packs with 4 in each pack)
- Pencils (4 packs with 12 in each pack: preferably pre-sharpened)



- 1 Pencil Pouch (Put pencil pouch in binder)
 - Items to keep in pencil pouch:
 - Scissors (1 **SMALL** pair)
 - Erasers
 - Highlighters (2 or 3)
 - Colored pencils (small pack)
 - Pack of Sticky Notes
 - Earbuds
- 1 One subject spiral notebook with at least 70 pages to put in binder
- 8 Composition Notebooks
- Agenda: Purchase from school for \$5.00
- 1 Container Clorox or Lysol Wipes (extras welcome!)
- **Sterilite** Crate from Wal-mart: Students will store belongings in the crate during the school year and may bring it home at the end of the year. (preferably dark blue, **must be STERILITE brand so we can hook them all together**)
