## **What You Can Expect at HCS Kindergarten - Lots of Fun!**

Kindergarten is a time when teachers try to instill a lifelong love of learning in their students. How do they do this? By making learning fun, of course! Story-time, art, field trips, special visitors, learning games, board games, puzzles, large motor games and activities—these are all staples of any Kindergarten curriculum. Your child will be having so much fun that he may not even realize how much he's learning.

There will be field trips throughout the year and parents are more than welcome to attend them. Some of these field trips could include: the pumpkin patch, Hermiston Fire Department, Sage Center, Hermiston Sanitary Station, bowling alley, as well as others which are used as a added learning tool to the many different things we are learning during the year. The transportation to and from is HCS's school bus.

Our PE program consists of doing different activities to encourage teamwork, flexibility, improve hand eye coordination, as well as individual growth. Your child will have PE twice a week and you will need to provide a school PE uniform.

Kindergarteners will have Library each week. They will be allowed to check out one book each week to take home to enjoy, then return it to the library the following week so they can check out another one.

A joint Chapel time is held with the Preschool, 1st, 2nd and 3rd grade each Wednesday morning. Scripture memorization is also a large part of our learning. We believe that the Word of God is not only food for our souls, but that memorization is also "exercise for the brain."

As part of their "break" times, kindergarten students have a "snack break." The teacher will create a snack calendar and each family will take turns bringing snacks to share with the class.

Certificates of achievement are given at the end of each quarter. At the end of the school year, a Kindergarten graduation is held, and along with their diplomas, the graduating kindergarteners are presented with awards individually earned in the categories of Scripture Memory, Perfect Attendance, Good Housekeeping, Penmanship, Most Improved, and Citizenship. It is a very special, exciting event for them.

The HCS kindergarten program is designed to thoroughly prepare each student for our own first grade program, but it is excellent preparation for any first grade program.

**Transportation:** No transportation to and from school is provided. Students are transported to and from school by a parent or parent designee. All persons who will be picking up your child **MUST** be either listed on your registration sheet or you must call ahead and then have the person provide identification. We cannot release children to individuals not designated and identified.

**Tuition:** Kindergarten registration is \$100.00, which includes an art fee, and is payable upon registering your child. This is a non-refundable registration fee. Annual tuition is \$3,860.00 . If paid in full before August 15, a 5% discount is given for cash or check payments. A 2.5% discount will be applied for credit/debit card payments. Tuition can also be paid on a 10-month basis, beginning Aug. 15, or on a 12-month basis, beginning June 15. Payments can be made in either the church or school office, mailed in, or Visa/Mastercard credit or debit is available in the church office. If you would like to set up a recurring payment for the same day each month on your debit/credit card, that option is available, also.

# HCS KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM

Hermiston Christian School Kindergarten is a full-day program, Monday-Thursday, from 8:30am to 4:00 pm

## Kindergarten Social Skills:

- Develop better self-control skills such as sitting still and listening quietly.
- Learn how to follow directions.
- Become more skilled at cooperating with others.
- Discuss families, holidays, and other things about their worlds.

## Kindergarten Reading and Writing:

- The base of our program is the ABC'S OF ACE phonics reading program. With this lively, entertaining program, children learn to read using stories, songs, and activities that surround their animal friends.
- Review letters of the alphabet and corresponding sounds.
- Learn lowercase and uppercase letters.
- Learn sight words, such as "the," "and" "is", "too", "of", and "as".
- Learn stories, songs, rhyming words.
- Talk about stories after reading them (a demonstration of reading comprehension): predict what may happen next, try to guess what characters might be thinking or feeling; re-tell what happened in the stories.

## Kindergarten Math:

- Count things around the classroom, such as how many days they've been at school, how many blocks are in a bin.
- Identify basic shapes such as circle, square, triangle, etc.
- Recognize numerals up to 20 and beyond.
- Count by 5s and 10s,
- Count from 0 - 100.
- Tackle basic addition.
- Understand concepts such as "more than" or "equal to."
- Create patterns with small objects and sort into groups by color and size.
- Identify coins (be able to distinguish between pennies, dimes, etc.).
- The Kindergarten math curriculum focuses on allowing students to develop a common understanding of how math concepts relate to their world. Mathematics is more than facts and computation. In kindergarten, students build a 'hands-on' and "concrete" sense of number, value and mathematical thinking.

## Kindergarten Science:

- Explore their world through observation and experimentation. Teach them to use their natural curiosity to help them learn about their world.
- Discover what animals and plants need to live and grow.
- Learn about the parts of the body and the senses.
- Become familiar with elements that make up our planet (earth, sand, rocks, water, etc.).
- Learn about changes in seasons and weather.
