

FREE MEALS FOR STUDENTS

The USDA announced a waiver extension that will allow children access to free meals through December 31, 2020.

What Does This Mean For Moniteau School District Families?

- We have been providing free meals to all students since the first day of school.
- Students can receive 1 breakfast and 1 lunch at no cost for each day school is in session.
 - Extra items are available to be purchased in addition to the meals.
 - If a complete meal is not taken, individual items will be charged the a la carte price. Ex: A carton of milk is not a complete meal and will be charged \$0.55 each.
- This program will remain in effect until December 31, 2020 or until the USDA does not have available funding. We will notify you of any changes in funding.
- Funds currently available on your student's meal account will remain on their account for use when the USDA waiver expires.
- All student's eligibility status will revert back to the correct status, Free, Reduced Price or Full Paid Price on January 1, 2021.
 - Please be sure to complete your Free and Reduced Priced meal application now to determine if your students are eligible to continue meal benefits after December 31, 2020.
 - The application can be completed at www.schoolcafe.com.
