**Age Requirement:** Children must be five years old on or before August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 to register for Kindergarten.

### REQUIRED Documents to Complete the Registration Process:

- Child's original birth certificate
- Child's immunization records to date
- 2 proofs of residency (i.e. driver's license, utility bill, construction/purchase agreement, rental agreement that shows current address)
- Custody Papers, if applicable

### Pennsylvania State Law requires each child entering school for the first time to have the following before school begins:

- Immunizations: Diphtheria, Tetanus and Acellular Pertussis, Polio, Measles/Mumps/Rubella, Hepatitis B and Varicella (Chicken Pox Vaccine)
- A complete physical and dental examination: The physical examination will be accepted 6 months prior to school entry.

### SUGGESTED Information to Provide at Registration:

- Child's Transportation Arrangements
- Medical Information (i.e. medications, allergies, special diet, etc.)

Students will work with teachers, reading specialists, speech pathologists and the school nurse to participate in screening activities.
