Dear Arizona Taxpayer:

Now that our school year is in full swing, we want to alert you to an exceptional opportunity for you and for our schools.

Arizona is fortunate to offer a tax credit on state taxes. This applies to all Arizona taxpayers. Any taxpayer may contribute up to \$200.00 per individual or \$400.00 per couple, to any fee-required extra-curricular activity offered at the school. This is a direct credit, not a deduction. That means it is subtracted from the taxes you owe and is fully refunded for up to the \$200 or \$400 amount. For example, if you regularly owe \$400 a year in Arizona state income taxes and you give \$400 to Cobre Valley Institute of Technology (CVIT), you would owe ZERO for that year for which you gave the contribution. It literally costs you nothing to give the money. It comes back to you as a credit, refund or reduction. Remember, this is for STATE taxes only.

This is a wonderful win/win situation. As a taxpayer, you are able to reduce your tax burden while contributing directly to the school programs of your choice. We would welcome any amount.

All of our Career & Technical Student Organizations (CTSO's) are eligible to receive this funding, as well as CTE Industry Certification Assessments and Extracurricular Activity costs. Your CVIT School Board and CVIT Administration ask for your participation.

We urge you to help share this message with all Arizona taxpayers, your friends, neighbors and relatives. It's time to take advantage of this ability to benefit our students.
