

Drawing portrait

THIS IS A 3 WEEK ASSIGNMENT (OUTLINES ARE DUE AT THE END OF THE WEEK) NEXT WEEKS ASSIGNMENT WILL BE ADD VALUE

Assignment --- draw the **outlines** of a **realistic looking photo of someone on your phone or in your family** to be completed in **pencil and eraser using what supplies you have on drawing or typing paper**. The picture is to be an **interesting close-up 3/4 view. (Showing the whole face, not from the side or front view.) Expressions , hands, hats are always more interesting.** Take care not to hide the features. **Choose a picture that has good value contrast and appears 3-D.** Project is to turned in after the outline drawing is complete for a grade. Next weeks assignment will be add value to show form.

- * You need a normal pencil with an eraser and a piece of paper.
- * Paper size no smaller than typing paper. (leave 1/4" for border)
- * Use drawing paper if dropped off, or you may use typing paper.
- * **Capture uniqueness & detail. Interesting pose.**
- * If you graph, 1/2" square on print out or photo, 1/2" or 3/4" squares on drawing paper.
- * **Draw lightly (OUTLINES ONLY, THEN SUBMIT FOR A GRADE)**

Submission - turn in the outline of you drawing along with your reference in the same email. Try to make sure the pictures are aligned.

Assignments turned in are to have the following information in the border (outside of the image) to ensure you receive the correct grade. (name of the assignment, your name, name of your art class)
To submit for a grade - I suggest taking a picture with your phone & e-mail the image to me from your phone or computer.
